Girls Double Knitting Wool and Chunky Wool Bag



Use size No 7 (4.5 mm) and No 2 (7 mm) needles and double knitting wool + chunky wool, if available.

1 button

This pattern is knitted in garter stitch throughout. Cast on 25 sts on No 7 (4.5 mm) needles using double knitting wool – knit 10 rows in garter stitch.

Change to No 2 (7 mm) needles and using chunky wool, knit until the chunky piece measures 8 inches (20 cm).

Change to No 7 (4.5 mm) needles and DK wool and knit 6 rows. Row 7 make a buttonhole as follows – K 12 sts – wool forward Knit 2 together – continue to the end of the row. Knit 2 more rows – then cast off.

Sew up the sides and attach a button to correspond with the buttonhole. Make a handle – either cast on 4 sts and using DK knit for about 10 inches (25 cm). Or crochet a chain, use cord or plait some chunky wool. Attach the handle at the sides.

If you do not have chunky type wool, use 2×4 double knit or 3×4 ply. It is only necessary to change the thickness of the wool to get the shape ... plus the larger needles. You can use all sorts of wool including fuzzy and bobbly wool! Always try to make the weight up to thicker than the first and last 10×10^{-5} rows.
